

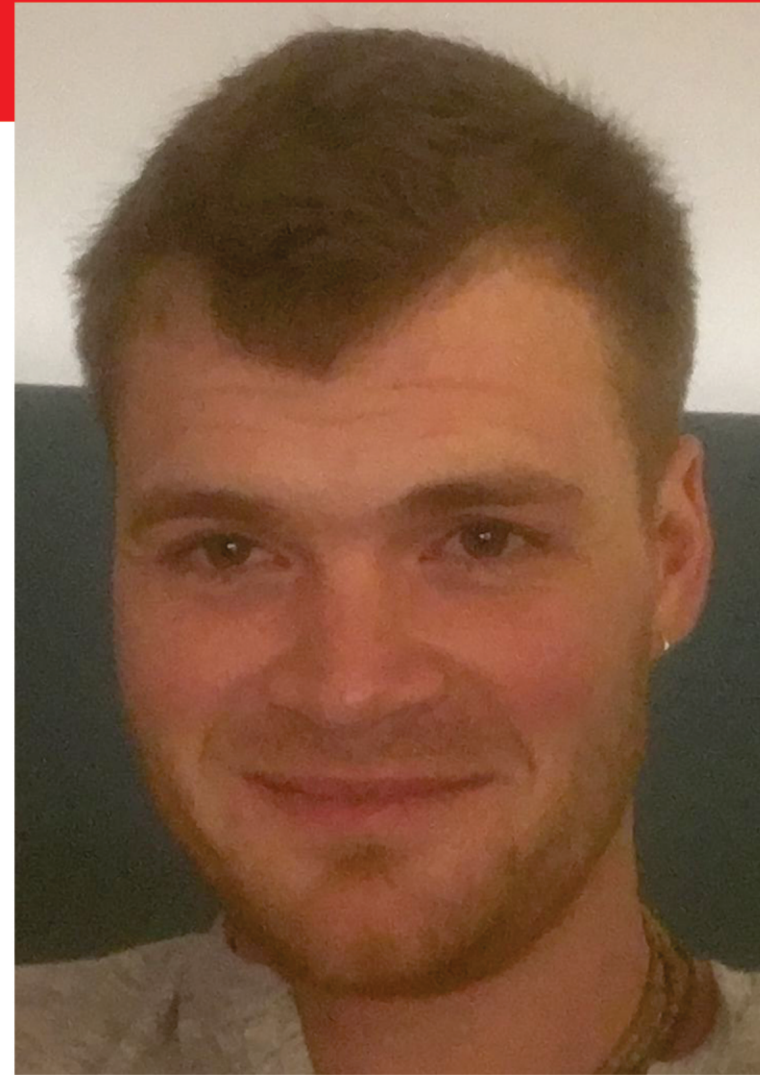
Dire Warning to International Devotee Community
